\*This is a therapy group which means that you will take part in therapy sessions. If you do not think you it is the course for you, you do not have to sign up and you will still be able to finish the specialization provided that you have taken other non-self-experience courses. The course takes place at Instytut Analizy Grupowej "Rasztów", ul. Genewska 9a, Warsaw.

\*\* This is a practical course taking place at the Academic Psychotherapy Centre (AOP). Yes, it is going to take place during weekends, because this is when AOP is going to be available.

\*\*\*These 3 courses will be taught during the weeklong trip which is going to take place in the week 24-30 April. If you want to go, you need to sign up for ALL three courses. The cost of transport, at least one meal a day and probably accommodation will be covered by the Faculty.

\*\*\*\* This course takes place at Banacha Hospital.

Courses from the Experimental Social Psychology specialization are financed by the EU (also if they are part of ESP and another specialization). If you complete a course, you will receive a part of your tuition fee back (30 PLN for 1 ECTS). Please contact the ESP coordinator for details.

Other requirements:

1. After the 4th year you need to accumulate at least 240 ECTS from all your current and previous courses. After the 5th year you need to accumulate at least 300 ECTS from all your courses (1 year = 60 ECTS). If you have 330, it will be ok, but there is an additional payment for the 331st and every next gained ECTS.
2. 21 ECTS from non-psychology OGUN classes by the end of your studies.
3. At least 48 ECTS from specialization courses during your 4th and 5th year (could be courses from different specializations). If you want to complete a concrete specialization, remember to fulfill all the criteria of this specialization.
4. Practice period (at least 100h) till the end of your studies.
